Footwear should include aerobic shoes with socks. Jazz shoes or dance sneakers are not required, but may be used if they are available. Hair should be pulled off the face. Please bring a large bottle of water to each clinic session—dancing is hard work and proper hydration is important!

The Formal Audition is by invitation only. It will take place on Thursday, June 4, in the same location. Audition invitations and schedules will be handed out on June 3 at the end of the clinic.
