

Glenelg Marching Unit Scrip Gift Card Program Information

*** General Information ***

Scrip Great Lakes Scrip Center is an online gift card purchase and rebate program that is available to non-profit organizations. There are over 700 retailers which offer rebates that typically range from 3% - 15%, but in some cases go significantly higher. There is no cost to enroll and no obligation to make any purchases.

*** How does it work? ***

You purchase gift cards through the Scrip program and then use them as payment for your favorite retailers, just like cash.

*** What happens to the rebates? ***

All gift card rebates are initially deposited into the marching unit boosters' Scrip account. The funds are then credited toward student subcontractor commission accounts as follows: 70 percent of the rebates go to the student commission account and 30 percent go into the marching unit general fund. Distribution of funds happens in accordance with all other GMUB fund raisers.

*** How do I sign up? ***

- Go to www.ShopWithScrip.com
- Click on "Get Started" then "Join Your Existing Program"
- Contact the GMUB gift card coordinator at dianechoy88@gmail.com to obtain the GMUB account enrollment code
- Create your account in typical online fashion

*** Physical vs. electronic cards ***

Traditional physical cards are the ones that you swipe when making in-store purchases and/or enter the code when making online purchases. They are delivered in bulk to the program coordinator once per week. Electronic versions of the cards (called ScripNow) are offered by most of the retailers and you can redeem them by having the bar code scanned from your smart phone or by manually entering the code.

*** How do I order cards? ***

You order your cards, whether physical or electronic, from your own Scrip account on your computer or smart phone. The GMUB coordinator "releases" a bulk order once per week. NOTE: If you order electronic (ScripNow) cards with electronic fund transfer (PrestoPay) then your order is released immediately without having to wait for the coordinator to take any action. This is handy when you want to order and/or use them on the spur of the moment.

*** What are the payment methods? ***

- 1) Check made payable to "GHS Certificate Program". Please place your check in an envelope marked "Scrip" and have it delivered to the Glenelg front office by Friday at lunchtime in order to make sure that your order is released and delivered by the following Friday.
- 2) If you optionally decide to set up electronic fund transfer from your bank account (called PrestoPay in Scrip language) then you can pay for your order online from your computer or smart phone.

*** What is the order and delivery schedule? ***

We are currently running on a Friday-to-Friday order and delivery schedule. Orders must be placed and checks received in the Glenelg front office (if paying by check) by Friday at lunchtime. Cards are available for pickup in the Glenelg front office the following Friday. You can have your student pick them up, pick them up yourself, or make other arrangements if necessary.
